It was an interactive session where students from NIT SRINAGAR and outside got an opportunity to explore all the possible options.



The panel discussion was over with vote of thanks. The panel discussion ended with an enlightening message given by the panel to the students.






Idea Pitching Workshop



PROBLEMS OF ELECTRICITY IN RURAL J&K

Jammu and Kashmir is popularly known as paradise on earth due to its serene views, lush green beauty and availability of many natural treasures of life. despite having all these natural blessings and treasures the denizens of this region are facing lot of hardship and miseries of life.

Topographically the rural areas of J&K are very inaccessible and isolated. Moreover due to various climatic barriers and other natural hindrances it is very difficult to provide all the hour power supply. As we all know during


rainy and season snowing many electric poles get damaged and effected by the natural way. But it is very unwise to blame only nature for this improper power supply there are alot of generation power plant in J&K even we r the suppliers of extra power in other states but in our state we are facing shortage and deficient power

Even as India hardly produces enough energy to fulfil it's domestic demands, a major portion of the electricity produced is being

wasted. Nearly 20% of the electricity is lost due to technical and commercial reasons (AT&C Losses).

SECTOR DEVELOPMENT

Going by the RBI's industrywise distribution of projects sanctioned by banks, the share of the power sector the in overall infrastructure has significantly fallen in the last four years. In FY16, share of projects the related to power sector sector in the overall infrastructure was 57.1%, which fell to 45.4% in FY17; 36.5% in FY18; and 25.1% in FY19. Adding to worse, amid the ongoing slowdown, the growth in bank credit in this sector has contracted by 1.2% in the financial year so far.



A globally accepted source of employment generation is entrepreneurship development and as J&K is under development so, thinking about this electricity problem would definitely help to promote some ideas regarding entrepreneurship developments.

due Moreover low to voltage supply the poor students of these areas can not get proper time for study during night hours as they are generally busy in their different house hold chores and other agricultural works with their family during day time. In urban areas and well developed cities there is no such problems and burden on the life of school going chlidren. So difference this the is among the children rural and urban areas in terms of their lifestyle and facilities lead some major problems like lack of knowladge and guidance in the students of rural areas then how can we think about entrepreneurship and anything out of the box in these areas where people are not getting proper facilities.

Many other states where there is no power generation plant are enjoying the benifits of proper and uninterrupted power supply round the clock but in J&K only because of poor management and negligence of few people are forced to suffer.

Today in the modern world, electricity is one of the necessary requirement. Long electricity cuts effect many sectors as given below

PRODUCTION RATE

Long electricity cuts effects production rate because of the large power cuts company and small startups are not able to fulfill required

customer demands and damaged reputation have a long- term effect on company. Employees may not be able to complete their task when key equipment is down.

DAMAGE EQUIPMENT AND STORED COMPUTER DATA LOSS

STUDENTS DATA LOSS

In winters students are not able to study properly due to power cuts, also in harsh winters electric heating equipment are also not working because of power cuts. But to be remain fit heating equipment are necessary. Hot water for drinking, bathing is also not available.


The USP of this innovation is the cost factor as this ventilator would be way cheaper as compared to the ones imported from outside, said one of the group members who made the prototype.
