

Dr. Shah highlighted the importance of forests and their role in the environment. He said the main goal of the program was to encourage students to take a leading role in protecting the environment at grass root level.



'We will act always as a platform for young generation': Director

Srinagar, Feb 28: Under the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebrations, PG Department of Physics, National Institute of Technology (NIT) Srinagar on Monday celebrated the National Science Day 2022, in which a large number of Class XI-XII Science students from various schools of the valley participated.

The event was organized in association with the Sophisticated Analytical Instrumentation Facility (SAIF). Panjab University Chandigarh Under "Synergistic Training Program Utilizing the Scientific and Technological Infrastructure" Supported by the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India.

In his presidential address, Director NIT Prof. (Dr.) Rakesh Sehgal congratulated Department of Physics especially HOD MA Shah and Dr. Vijay Kumar for taking a lead role in celebrating National Science Day 2022 on the NIT campus.

"By organizing such events, we are in a position to give something back to our society. No doubt we are a professional institution imparting technical and science education at all levels but NIT will act always as a platform for the young generation," he said.

Prof. Sehgal said the theme of National Science Day 2022 is Integrated Approach in Science and Technology for Sustainable Future'. It is given by honorable Union Minister for Science and Technology, Dr. Jitendra Singh, he said.

Director said from Medical

sciences to agriculture, India is progressing inevery field with science and technology. No technology will be successful until we make it sustainable. Now we are moving towards non-conventional resources, wind, solar energy because people have started thinking about sustainable development, he said.

Registrar NIT Srinagar, Prof. Syed Kaiser Bukhari said no country can achieve sustainable development goals alone, international scientific cooperation contributes not only to scientific knowledge but also to building peace.

"Achieving sustainability in development demands new knowledge, which science and technology must provide. Research and innovation are essential to increase our abilities to deal with sustainable development challenges," he said.

Prof. Bukhari said there is a need to understand a phenomenon and its causes; assess impact, magnitude, time scale, and probability. We need to predict trends the effects of taking specific actions. We need to develop and test solutions; predict outcomes and mitigate harm and make informed policy decisions, he said.

Hefurthersaid the biological and physical sciences and engineering must work closely with the social and behavioral sciences to speed the application of innovations and insights to the needs of society.

"Although new technologies have made our lives more comfortable and easier. They have also bad effects



on us. In the modern world, we have incredible communication technologies but we are alone. We love each other less than before. I believe that we should use these technologies but not let them make our hearts far each other," Prof. Bukhari added.

President Private Schools' Association J&K, G. N. Varsaid there is a need to encourage and inspire students from a young age so that they canwork on scientific innovations and make the world better place to live besides creating new livelihood opportunities.

Var stressed the preservation of the environment to achieve sustainable development goals. He also highlighted the importance of the National Science Day and its approach in working across disciplines. Appreciating the administration for taking such initiatives, has assured full support for making a smooth trajectory between Schools and NIT Srinagar.

MA Shah, the goal of the program was to encourage students to take a leading role in science and technology.





World-famous cardiologist Dr Riyaz Bashir delivers lecture on medical innovations at NIT Srinagar

Srinagar, May 19: World famous cardiologist Dr Riyaz Bashir MD, FACC, who is Professor of Medicine, Lewis Katz School of Medicine at Temple University, USA, Wednesday delivered an expert lecture on medical innovations at National Institute of Technology (NIT) Srinagar.

The event was organized jointly by MSME, Development Institute Srinagar in collaboration with MSME- Business Incubation Centre and IEED Centre.

The event was presided over by Director NIT Srinagar, Prof. Rakesh Sehgal, and world-renowned cardiologist Dr Riyaz Bashir who is also Director, Vascular and Endovascular Medicine and co-inventor of the Bashir[™] Endovascular Catheter was the chief guest on the occasion.

In his presiding speech, Director NIT, Prof. Sehgal said new innovations are important and vital for any engineering institution. From medical sciences to agriculture, India is progressing in every field of science and technology. No technology will be successful until we make it sustainable, he said

Prof. Sehgal also expressed his gratitude to Dr Riyaz Bashir for delivering a memorable lecture on medical innovations. Hosting such renowned personalities is the need of the hour, he said.

Syed Kaiser Bukhari said research and innovation are essential to increase the abilities of young minds.

"We need to develop and test solutions; predict outcomes and mitigate harm and make informed policy decisions," he said. Prof. Bukhari said research and innovation are critical for generating new knowledge, building new infrastructure, and educating innovators and entrepreneurs. In his key address, Dr Riyaz Bashir delivered his lecture on medical innovations and shared his aspiring journey from Kashmir to the USA with the young innovators.

"Our team is working on removing the blockage of lung arteries by a blood clot results in pulmonary embolism – a condition requiring emergency care that affects thousands of patients across the globe," he said.

Dr. Bashir further said existing treatments, however, may not fully remove the clot, necessitating the development of new therapeutic strategies for pulmonary embolism.

His team has developed a device known as the Bashir™ Endovascular Catheter (Thrombolex, Inc.), which effectively dissolves the clots in the lungs, with no major bleeding risk.

Dr Bashir also urged young innovators to focus on a problem and then try to find the best solutions possible. "Universe will conspire to make it successful if your intention is to help people and impact lives," he said. Assistant Di-rector, MSME Development Institute Srinagar, Saheel Yagoob Alagband said the program was aimed to motivate young innovators, and how they will take their innovation to commercial stage. istry of MSME funds those innovations which have commercial potential and later can change the lives of the people. 
