
(Regarding Income Certificates for Fee Remission)

Dated: 04.03.2025

It had been observed that a large number of students submitted multiple income certificates with changed income levels (each time lesser income) during the period of their programme, which on the one hand cast doubt on the authenticity of income shown on these income certificates and on the other hand affected adversely the IRG of the Institute. In the backdrop of this, the change of income category had been stopped w. e. f. July 2024. Since then, many students have submitted income certificates with changed (lower) family incomes and have requested for change of fee remission in their favour.


The competent authority has approved the income change and subsequent change in fee remissions, subject to the fulfillment of following conditions:

1. The fee-remission would be changed based on income certificates submitted by students subject to the production of Affidavits prepared (in given format) on stamp paper with attestation of a first-class magistrate (both by student and Parent/Guardian). The format of the Affidavits is attached with this Notice.
2. Income certificates submitted for change of fee remissions **would be got verified from third parties for actual family income levels**. If the student is found to have produced a certificate with family income less than the actual income (**even if he/she has managed to get an income certificate with lower income**) his/her admission will be cancelled (and if found after award of degree, the degree will be declared invalid).
3. A legal case will be initiated against the parent/s of a student if, after verification, the actual income of his/her family is found to be higher than the figures mentioned in the income certificate.
4. The Income Certificate being valid for one year, can be changed only once in a financial year. The certificate should have been issued on or after 1st April and its validity will be from 01 April to subsequent 31st March.
