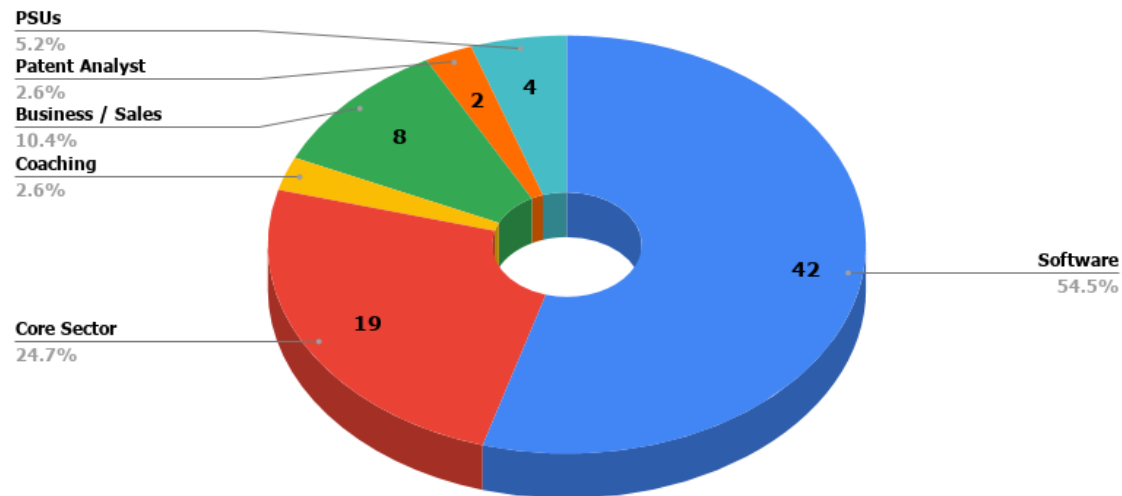

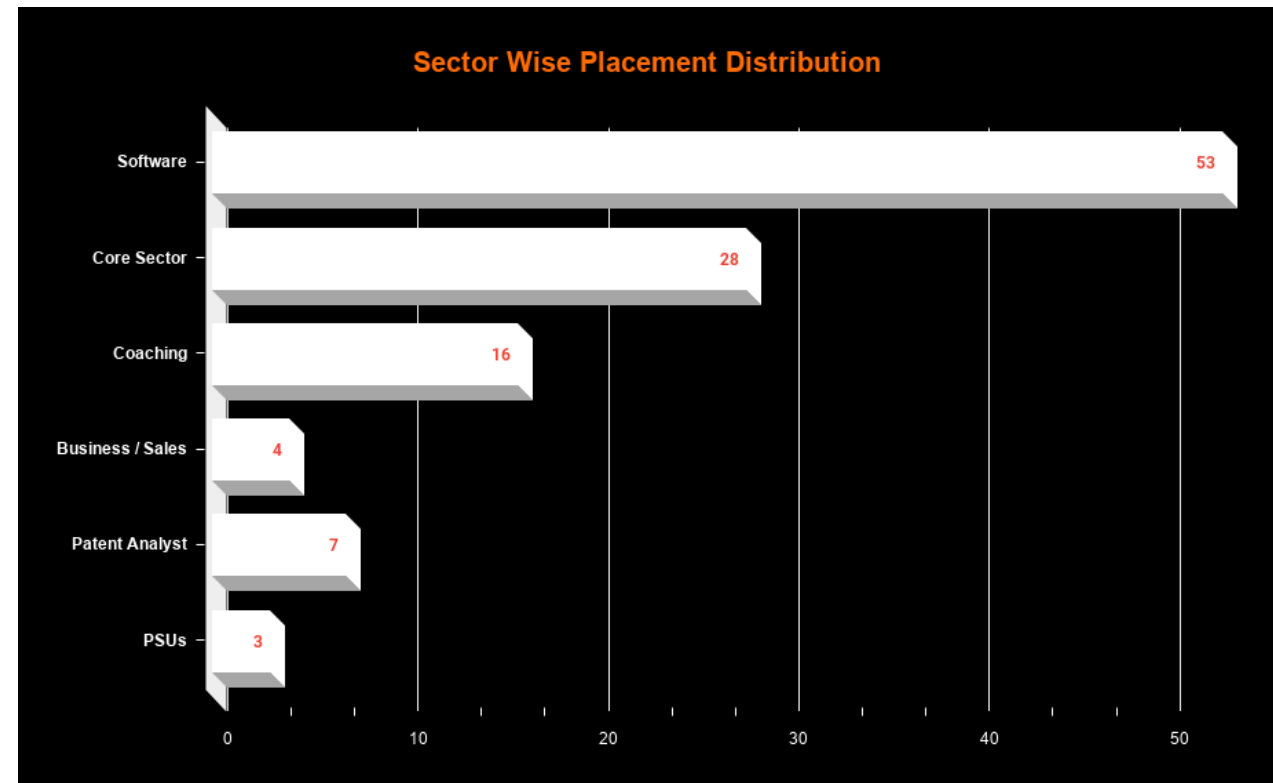
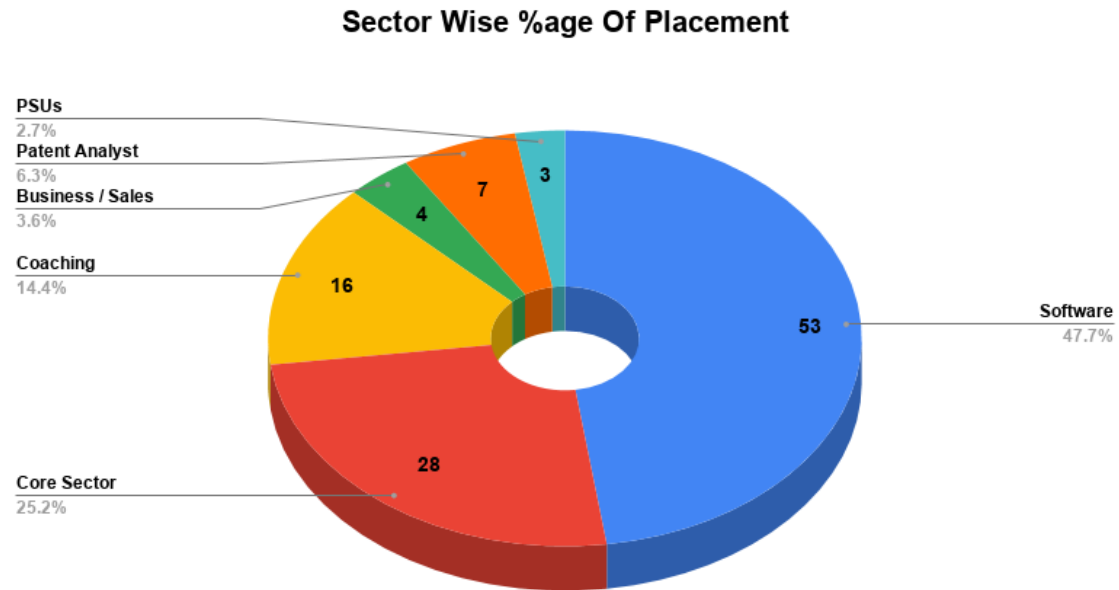
Sector Wise %age Of Company
